





Jesus Rejected at Nazareth


16 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. And as was his custom, he went to the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and he stood up to read.

What we have heard you did at Capernaum, do here in your hometown as well." 24 And he said, "Truly, I say to you, no prophet is acceptable in his hometown. ²⁵ But in truth, I tell you, there were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heavens were shut up three years and six months, and a great famine came over all the land, ²⁶ and Elijah was sent to none of them but only to Zarephath, in the land of Sidon, to a woman who was a widow. ²⁷ And there were many lepers [a] in Israel in the time of the prophet Elisha, and none of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian." 28 When they heard these things, all in the synagogue were filled with wrath. ²⁹ And they rose up and drove him out of the town and brought him to the brow of the hill on which their town was built, so that they could throw him down the cliff. 30 But passing through their midst, he went away.

- ♦(first coming vs. second coming)


New Covenant

Jeremiah 34:18-19

And the men who transgressed my covenant and did not keep the terms of the covenant that they made before me, I will make them like the calf that they cut in two and passed between its parts—the officials of Judah, the officials of Jerusalem, the eunuchs, the priests, and all the people of the land who passed between the parts of the calf.







Jer. 31

"Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, ³² not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD. 33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 34 And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 2

And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, . . . remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called "the uncircumcision" by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands— 12 remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. ¹³ But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. 14 For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility 15 by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, ¹⁶ and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. 17 And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near.

Restore

- 1. Jeremiah 27:22 I will bring them back and restore them to this place."
- 2. Jeremiah 29:14 I will be found by you, declares the Lord, and I will restore your fortunes and gather you from all the nations and all the places where I have driven you
- 3. Jeremiah 30:3 For behold, days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will restore the fortunes of my people
- 4. Jeremiah 30:17 For I will restore health to you, and your wounds I will heal
- 5. Jeremiah 30:18 I will restore the fortunes of the tents of Jacob

Jer. 33 - The Jeconiah Problem

- ♦ Jeconiah / Johoiachin (I Chron 3) / Coniah (Jer. 22:24)
- King of Judah deported to Babylon
- * "None of his offspring will prosper, none will sit on the throne of David or rule anymore in Judah" (Jer. 22:30)
- ♦ A "Son of David" will sit on the throne of David and reign forever. (I Chron. 17; Jer. 33:14-25)
- ♦ Jeconiah is in the David-Mary-Jesus line.
- ♦ Several possible answers to this problem.
- Virgin birth offers one intriguing answer!
- Legal status of son of David through adopted Father Joseph
