

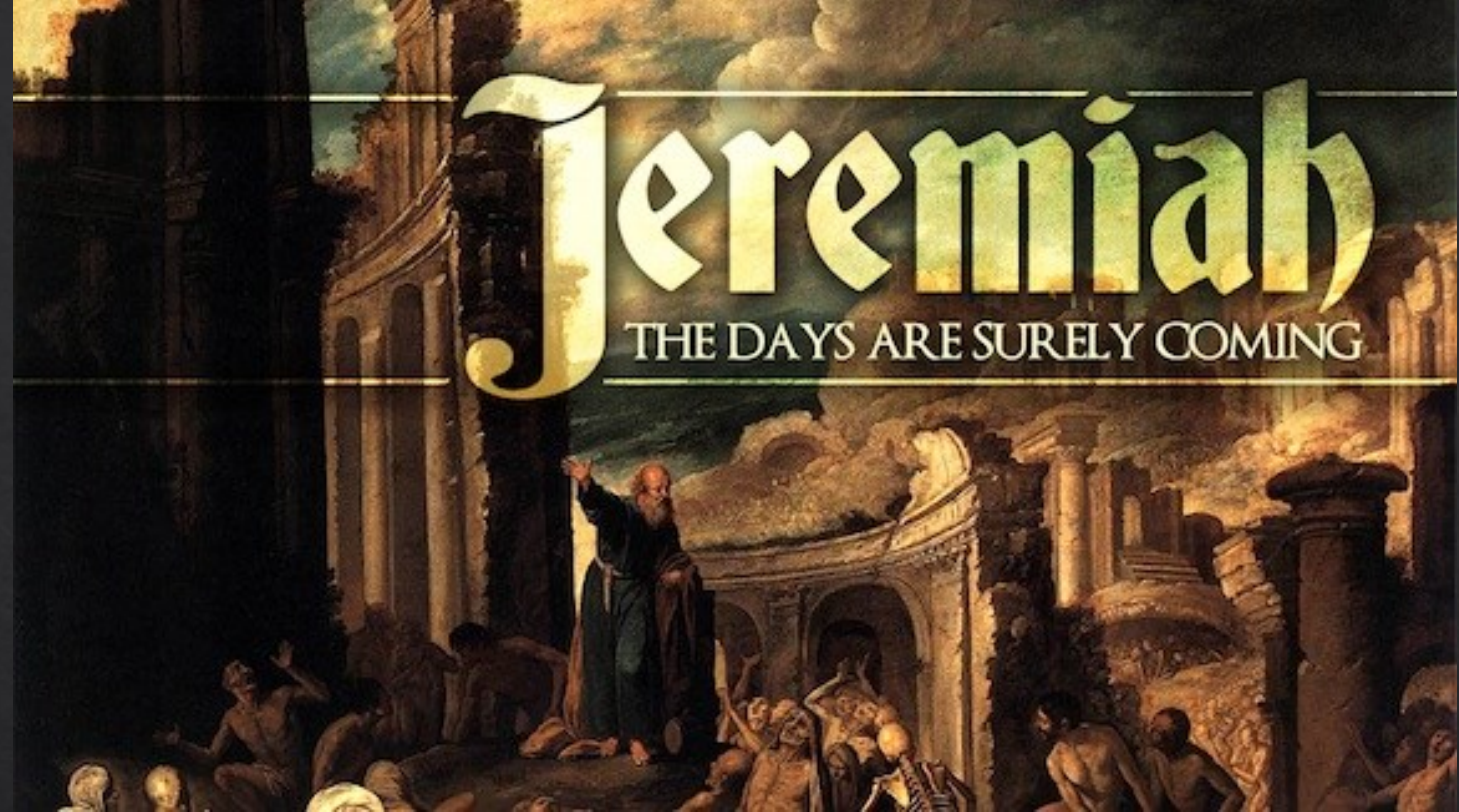

Mt. 22

33 "Hear another parable. There was a master of a house who planted a vineyard and put a fence around it and dug a winepress in it and built a tower and leased it to tenants, and went into another country. **34** When the season for fruit drew near, he sent his servants^[c] to the tenants to get his fruit. **35** And the tenants took his servants and beat one, killed another, and stoned another. **36** Again he sent other servants, more than the first. And they did the same to them. **37** Finally he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.' **38** But when the tenants saw the son, they said to themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and have his inheritance.' **39** And they took him and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. **40** When therefore the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?" **41** They said to him, "He will put those wretches to a miserable death and let out the vineyard to other tenants who will give him the fruits in their seasons."

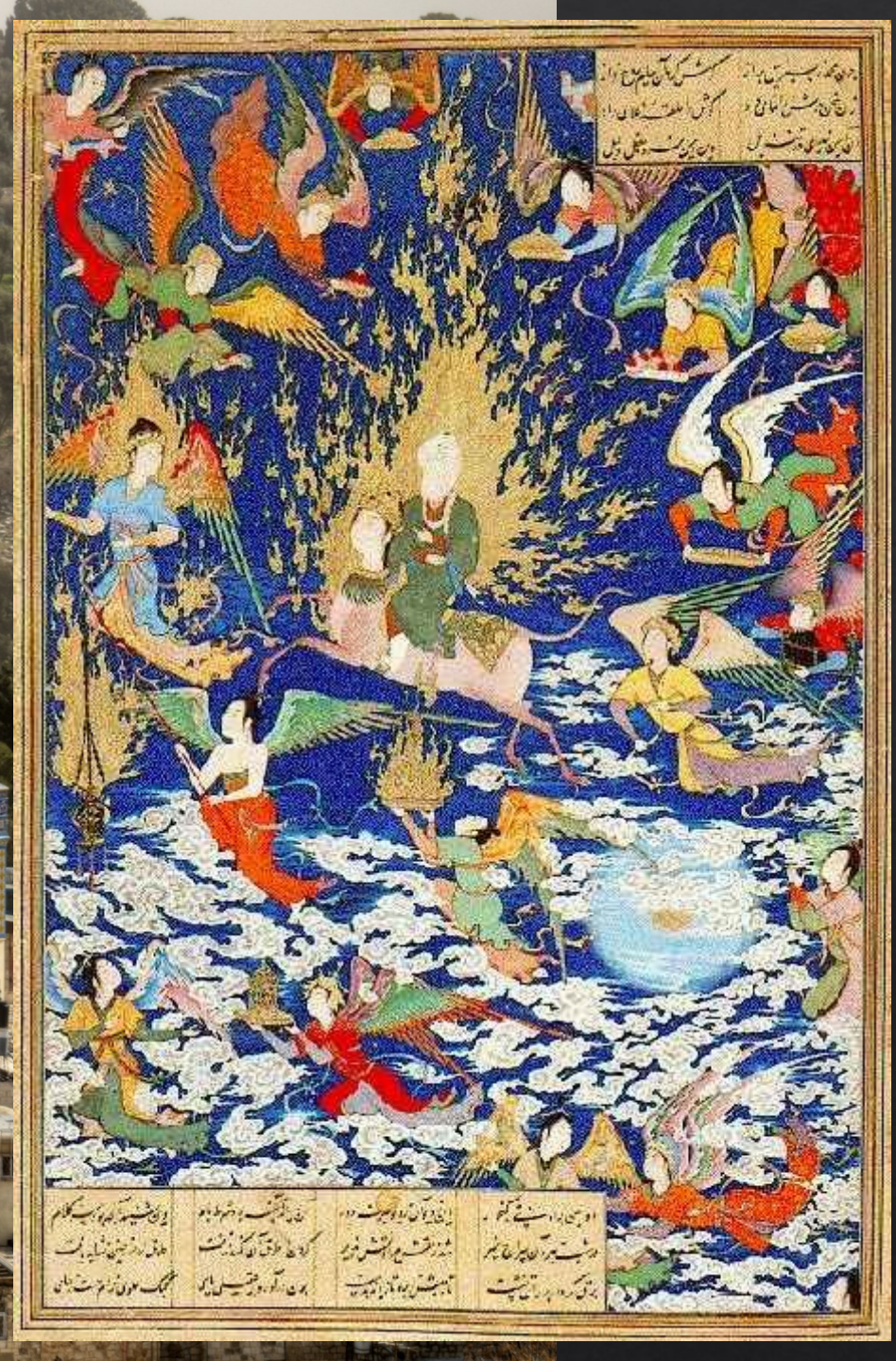

Thus saith Koresh (Cyrus) king of Paras (Persia): All the kingdoms of the earth hath Hashem, the God of heaven, given me; and He hath charged me to build Him a house in Yerushalayim, which is in Yehuda. Ezra 1:2

The comparison was so apt that it was **adopted by Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu who also compared the U.S. president to the Persian King.**

◇ “The hands of compassionate women have boiled their own children; they became food...” (Lam.4:10)

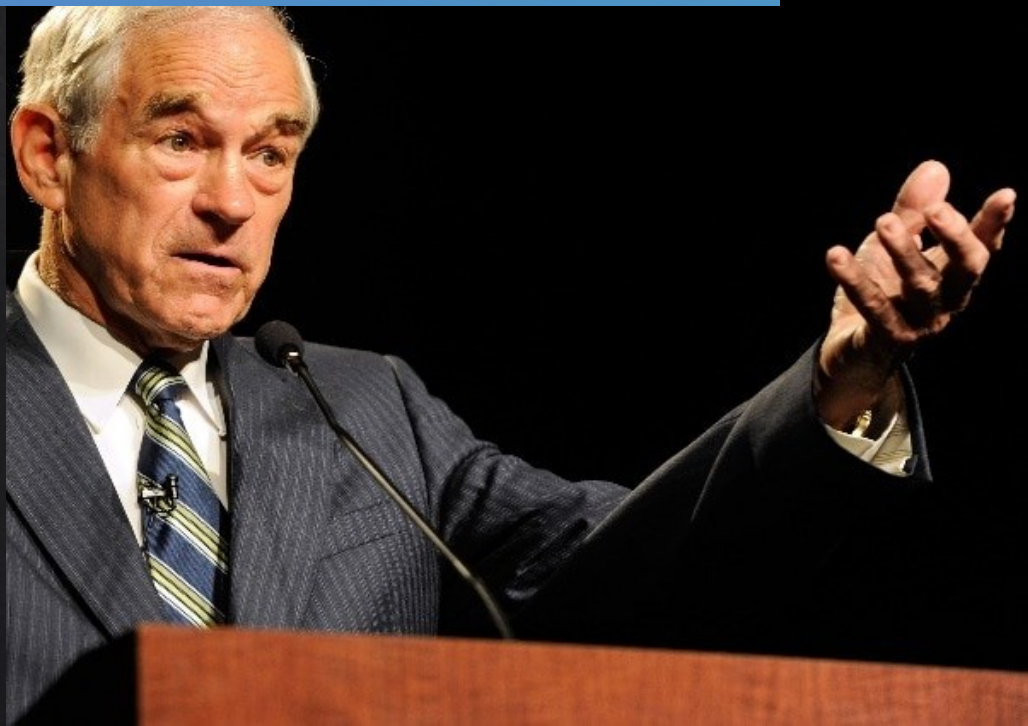

Paul's Visions and His Thorn

12 I must go on boasting. Though there is nothing to be gained by it, I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord. **2** I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven—whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows. **3** And I know that this man was caught up into paradise—whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows— **4** and he heard things that cannot be told, which man may not utter. **5** On behalf of this man I will boast, but on my own behalf I will not boast, except of my weaknesses— **6** though if I should wish to boast, I would not be a fool, for I would be speaking the truth; but I refrain from it, so that no one may think more of me than he sees in me or hears from me. **7** So to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations,^[a] a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited. **8** Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. **9** But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.”

Ezekiel 10

3 Now the cherubim were standing on the south side of **the house**, when the man went in, and a cloud filled the inner court. 4 And the **glory of the Lord went up from the cherub to the threshold of the house**, and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was filled with the brightness of the glory of the Lord. ... 18 Then the glory of the Lord went out from the **threshold of the house, and stood over the cherubim**. 19 And the cherubim lifted up their wings and mounted up **from the earth** before my eyes as they went out, with the wheels beside them. And they stood at the entrance of the east gate of the house of the Lord, and **the glory of the God of Israel was over them**. 20 These were the living creatures that I saw underneath the God of Israel by the Chebar canal; and I knew that they were cherubim. 21 Each had four faces, and each four wings, and underneath their wings the likeness of human hands. 22 And as for the likeness of their faces, they were the same faces whose appearance I had seen by the Chebar canal. Each one of them went straight forward.

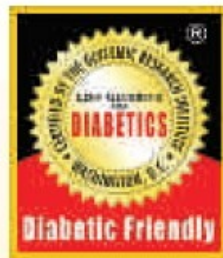

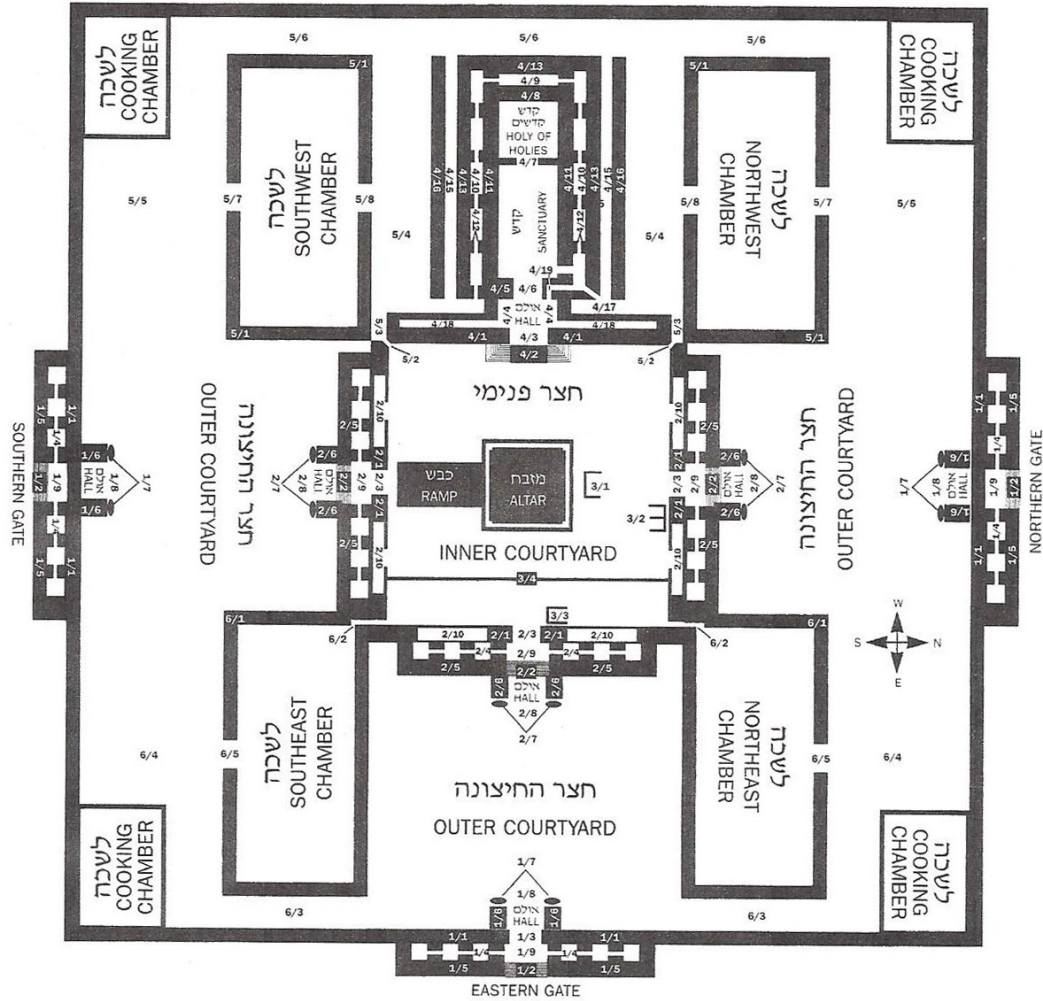

As set forth in Ezekiel Chapters 40-43

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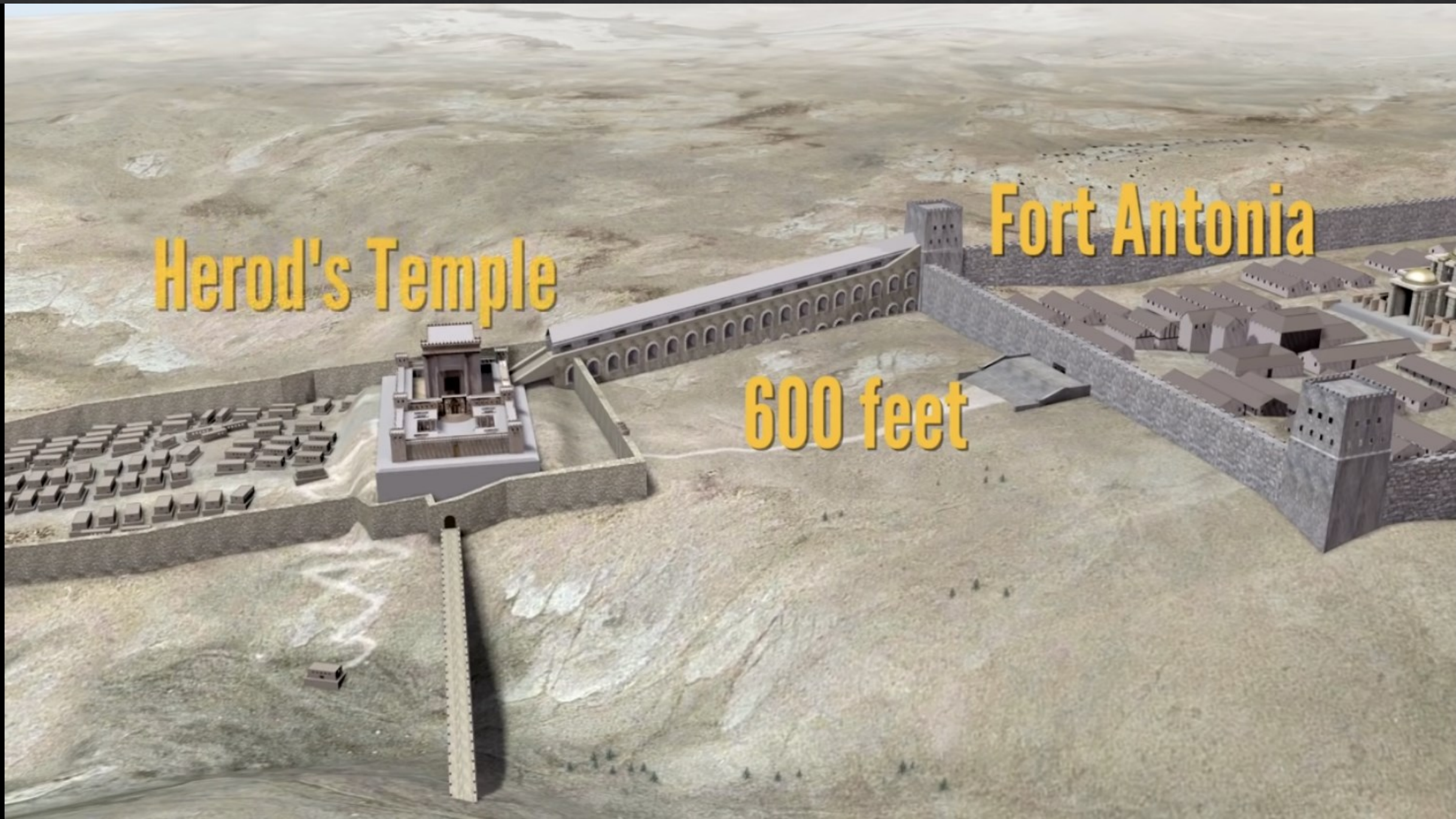
This diagram attempts to present the layout of Ezekiel's Temple as closely as possible to the way *Rashi* must have understood it.
